



Freelance Recruiter - Job Description

Are you worried about the apparent deadlock in UK politics, and terrified that the Tories could win again?

At the 2017 General Election, Campaign Together mobilised thousands of people from any political affiliation or none, to canvass against the Tories in marginal seats. Horrified by the privatisation and running down of public services, breakdown in environmental progress, a 'hard deregulation Brexit', and a growing climate of racism, we used Bernie Sanders-style 'big organising' to support whichever progressive party was the clear front runner in marginal seats.

Now we are launching a longer campaign through the next local, London and General Elections, to make sure that we collectively push the Conservatives out of power this time. To game the unfair First Past The Post system, we are mobilising everybody who is not a member of a party, or whose chosen party does not stand a chance in their seat, to campaign together to get rid of this disastrous and dangerous government. We aim to organise patiently in communities, train ordinary people to become leaders, and mobilise 10,000 canvassers over the course of the campaign, flooding marginal seats and helping progressives to win in 50 parliamentary constituencies across the UK.

Join our team!

Campaign Together are currently recruiting for a two-month long freelance Organiser position, to help us recruit for two longer posts. Our ideal candidate will be able to hit the ground running, will agree with the values of the organisation, and will have be able to facilitate successful recruitments. They will also be able to support our Steering Group in further developing our national strategy.

The Organiser will:

- Recruit three new, diverse, talented individuals to join our growing Steering Group by working with the Steering Group to write up role descriptions, and promoting the roles.
- Administrate the recruitment of our two staff positions, including working with the Steering Group to write suitable job descriptions, promoting the positions broadly, and arranging interviews
- Work with our Steering Group in assessing applications, undertaking the interviews, and getting the new staff members in post
- Organise strategic meetings with our Steering Group to develop our 2018-2020 Strategy, including Fundraising, Communications, and Organising, and writing up the results and a rough timeline
- Help our Steering Group to develop our democratic decision-making processes at these meetings, both within the team and within the wider movement, including through research before the meeting
- Recruit two volunteers to work on the campaign, and getting them set up and trained
- Recruit a pro bono (voluntary) accountant

Working culture Campaign Together had a paid staff team during the 2017 General Election. Since then we have kept the organisation running via an unpaid Steering Group. The Steering Group is responsible for strategic oversight and development of the organisation. Our team is made up of passionate and committed people from UK social movements. We are equally committed to our organisation being a good place to work, and a fun and friendly environment. We all take responsibility for the big task of making a huge contribution

Working location The role will be working from home with most meetings online with occasional meetings in in London or Oxford.

Reporting to The role will report to the Steering Group of Campaign Together.

Start and end date You must be free to start on or before 8 June 2018, and to be available to work until the 7 August. If you have some holiday during this period you want to take we can discuss that at interview and it will not affect your chance of getting the role.

Working hours This is a full time role for two months. We would like this role to be done largely during normal working hours, so that our team can support you and be in contact with you, though we are open to discussing flexible working arrangements. If you could only do this role part time, but you believe you are a strong candidate, please contact us before applying and we can discuss whether a non-full time role could work.

Payment This is a freelance role, which will be paid £5000 in total, inclusive of any VAT.
